

Purpose of skip licence

1. The purpose of this licence is to enable an ESL member, where they do not have space on their own land, to place a skip on ESL land without payment for up to three weeks (eg to clear a garage) free of charge.
2. After the three week period the ESL member is required to pay a fee of £25 per week to keep a skip on ESL land.

SKIP LICENCE

This Agreement is made between:-

Purpose

The Licensee wishes to place a skip on ESL land at the Location and the Licensor is willing to grant the Licensee a licence to do so.

Definitions

Location means _____

In return for the Licensee's agreeing to restore ESL land at the Location to its condition before the skip was placed on ESL land, the Parties agree as follows:-

1. The Licensee must be a member of Elmer Sands Limited and have paid his or her subscriptions up to date.
2. From _____ until _____ the Licensee may place a skip at the Location without payment.
3. From _____ the Licensee agrees to pay the Licensor a fee of twenty-five pounds (£25) per week or part of a week to keep a skip at the Location until the termination of this Licence.

4. Termination

- 4.1 Either party may terminate this Licence by giving one week's written notice to the other party.
- 4.2 Following termination of this Licence the Licensee must, within seven (7) days of the termination, remove the skip and restore the ESL land at the Location to its previous condition. Failure to do so will entitle the Licensor to remove the skip, restore the ESL land at the Location to its previous condition and charge the Licensee for the cost of the skip removal and restoration of ESL land.

5. Damage

- 5.1 The Licensee agrees to compensate the Licensor for the cost of making good any damage to ESL land.

5.2 The Licensor has the sole right to determine how any such damage to ESL land is to be made good.

5. Payment

The Licensee may make payment either:-

(a) In advance of or during each week for which payment is due.

(b) by requesting that the sum owing be added to the annual subscription owing to Elmer Sands Ltd.

If the Licensee does not opt for either (a) or (b) above the sum owing will be added to the Licensee's annual subscription.
