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REPORT OF REGULAR PARKING PROBLEMS on the Elmer Sands Estate Roads and Verges

Due to the increasing costs of road and drainage maintenance that result from parking on verges and, in order to keep the roads free of vehicles for emergency and pedestrian access, the Council of Elmer Sands Limited has implemented a variety of schemes to reduce the number of vehicles parked on the roads and verges. However, the only way to effectively monitor parking across the whole Estate is for residents themselves to lend support.

Please submit reports to the Secretary using the form on the reverse of this notice to report any regular parking problems, based on the guidelines below:

ESL's guidelines:

One of the most important Estate rules concerns parking on the Estate roads and grass verges for reasons of **public safety and rain water drainage**. If your property has surface water drains they are under the verges. If not, the verge is your drain. Parking on the verge damages the drainage system in either case. Persistent parking on the edge of verges and roads breaks up the tarmac. This type of damage has to be repaired and funded by your annual subscription. The ESL Council fully appreciates that visitors will need to park on the roads from time to time, but it should be noted that **regular parking of any vehicle on the Estate roads and verges is trespass**.
